


Our national reach


Qscan Group operates 81 clinics in metro and regional areas across Australia, including stand-alone clinics, hospital contracts and teleradiology contracts.


We understand our patients often come to us in times of uncertainty and we take every possible step




Our fellowship programs are set in partnership with our new recruits to align to the aspirations of the individual.

We leverage the strengths of our existing specialists and expert mentors to ensure our fellows receive access to diverse case exposure and a strong breadth of diagnostic opportunities.

Transitioning to work as a consultant radiologist can be daunting. At Qscan your elevation to consultant level will occur through a gradual process within our private practice and be balanced with access to the hospital radiology environment through our strong partnerships.

Dedicated training days, conference leave, inclusion at our annual doctor conference and professional development feature throughout your fellowship program to ensure a well-rounded learning experience.

I completed a hybrid abdominal imaging fellowship with Qscan in 2020. The hybrid fellowship model facilitated a smooth transition into private practice, but also allowed me to develop subspecialty knowledge in my areas of interest.

In addition to abdominal imaging, during my fellow year I also received supervision in breast MRI and head and neck oncological imaging. These were both fields in which I had developed an interest as a registrar. The flexibility of the Qscan fellowship was ideal to allow me to further develop my knowledge in these subspecialties.

During the fellow year, I was given support to undertake additional training in breast imaging. In addition, Qscan has been centrally involved in establishing the weekly Queensland Private Head and Neck MDT, which I attend regularly.

In addition to working at Qscan, I hold appointments at Brestscreen and the Wesley Breast Clinic.
